Our approach is informed by our understanding of place and community needs, particularly in Elland and the lower valley, where access to resources can be limited.

Our approach to environmental sustainability covers 4 key principles:

- 1. Hyper-Local:** We will prioritise working within Calderdale to reduce travel emissions and support the local economy.
- 2. Resource Efficiency:** We will minimise waste by using reusable, borrowed, or sustainably sourced materials.
- 3. Social and Environmental Justice:** We will make our activities accessible and inclusive, supporting communities that are most affected by climate change and social inequality.
- 4. Community Engagement:** We will actively involve our community in sustainability discussions, promoting shared responsibility and knowledge exchange.
